

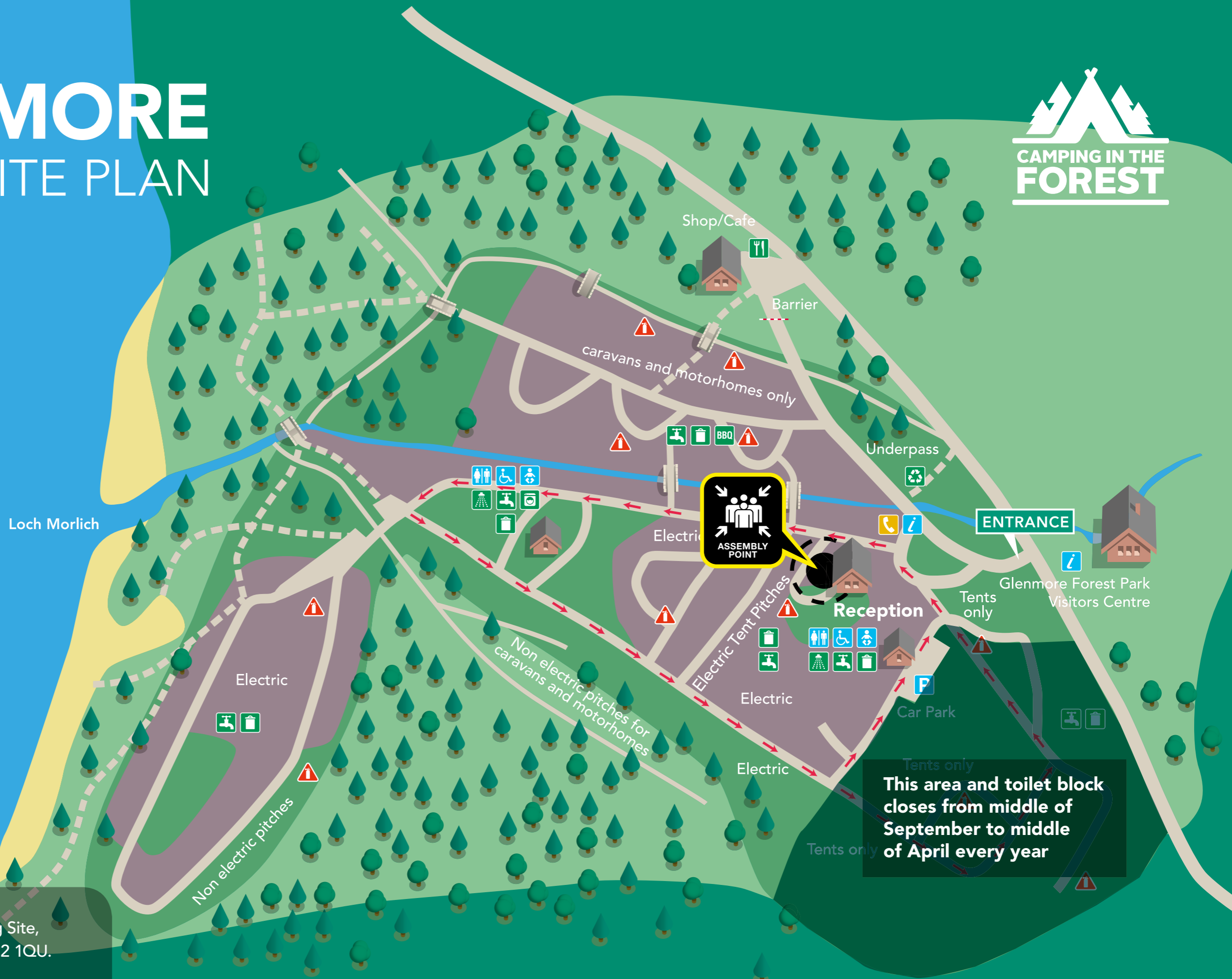

## Site Rules

### Reception

Opening times will be displayed at Reception. When Reception is closed an emergency contact number for the Site Manager will be displayed on the door. Local tourist information is available at Reception. For more information on the area, please do not hesitate to ask the Site Manager.

### Arrival/Departure

Pitches are available from noon on the day of your arrival. You are requested to vacate your pitch by 12 noon on your day of departure. If you wish to extend your stay, please contact Reception before 10.00am on your expected departure date.

Permits issued at Reception must be on display at all times.

### Arrivals when reception is closed

You may pitch up to 9.00pm or dusk if sooner. If you arrive when Reception is closed please read the signs and maps displayed on Reception door for pitching instructions.

Please return to Reception in the morning between 9.00am – 10.00am to pay and collect your permits.

The site is open between 8.00am and 10.00pm.

### Pitches

Please note that due to fire regulations you must pitch at least six metres away from anyone else. You will be asked to repitch if this rule is not adhered to. You will find fire extinguishers in prominent places around the site, please make yourself aware of where these are located.

One windbreak is permitted per pitch, with a maximum of six poles.

### \* Winter conditions at Glenmore

It is excellent for skiing on the Cairngorm Mountain, you can call the mountain for daily ski runs available on **01479 861261**. For weather updates please visit [www.mwis.org.uk](http://www.mwis.org.uk)

The campsite is 300 meters above sea level, and in the winter the site temperature is between -3 to as low as -22. Please make sure you have to hand your number for your recovery service, a snow shovel, snow chains and extra blankets and food.

### Speed limit

The speed limit onsite is 5mph, as there are often young children playing, we ask you to take special care when driving on site.

### Barbecues

Because of the danger of fires in the forest, open fires are not allowed onsite. Barbecues may be lit provided they are raised off the ground and are in a suitable container – no wood burning. Please ensure that smoke and fumes do not annoy other site users. In times of very dry weather, when the fire risk is high, the use of barbecues may be restricted. All barbecues must be extinguished by 10.00pm.

### Generators

Please note that generators are not permitted on this site.

### Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times whilst on site. Please be courteous and always clean up after your dog. There is a maximum of three dogs per pitch.

## Environment

Washing lines and tree swings are strictly prohibited on our sites. Likewise we do not permit fireworks or den building on or around the pitches.

## Wildlife

Please do not feed the animals in and around our sites.

## Noise

Please keep noise at a level which will not disturb other site users, especially between 10pm and 8am.

## Cycling

Cycling in the forest is permitted on public roads and waymarked routes only.

## Cleanliness

We make every effort to keep the site facilities clean and tidy and ask for your assistance in maintaining this standard by using the refuse and recycling bins and chemical disposal points provided, and by leaving all facilities clean after use.

## Visitors

If you are expecting any visitors, please be reminded that they should park and pay at Reception.
